1. Purpose

This report informs the Policy Committee of progress being made in the implementation of the projects detailed in 'Our Plan' 2013/16. The information provided covers any project developments in the period since the Policy Committee meeting on 5 November 2014.

2. Executive Summary

Progress is reported in respect of 9 projects that are currently in various stages of development or implementation.

3. Report Detail

Current Status of Projects

3.1 **Organisational Change Project** - The non-Integrated Risk Management Plan (IRMP) work streams within the project were approved for implementation by the Combined Fire Authority (CFA) on 25th September 2014. The IRMP proposals within the project were also approved for consultation at the same meeting. The IRMP consultation ran from October until the end of December 2014. At the time of writing this report there have been over 1,000 responses to the consultation. These include 270 submissions via the website and approximately 70 letters and e-mails. There has also been a co-ordinated submission of approximately 700 pre-printed letters from communities in Rutland.

Internal and external consultation events have taken place with over 150 attendees; the final events took place on 9th December 2014. A report summarising the IRMP consultation outcomes will be submitted to the CFA in February 2015.

The outcomes of the Support Staff Review are being progressed and individual consultations are taking place with those individuals whose posts were identified as

being 'at risk'.

3.2 **Birstall Headquarters and Fire and Rescue Station** – The Headquarters building and the new station were occupied in April 2013. The old Headquarters and Syston Station have both now been sold and the capital receipts received.

The project will be formally closed on receipt of the final invoices, completion of repair of the outstanding defects and following approval of a project closure report. The date for completion of resolving the final defects has been extended until the end of February 2015.

3.3 **New Facilities in the Castle Donington area** - This project will deliver a new fire and rescue station in the Castle Donington area.

Procurement of an industrial unit close to East Midlands Airport for the purpose of implementing a Day Crewing Plus (DCP) duty system has been successfully completed. Designs for the final building refurbishment have been created in conjunction with operational management. Installation of the temporary accommodation is complete and the crews commenced full DCP operational duties from 12th August 2014. Subject to the approval of the recently submitted planning application and receipt of a licence from the Manchester Airport Group, construction work is due to commence on 5th January 2015.

Collaboration discussions have taken place with the East Midlands Ambulance Service (EMAS) regarding them utilising space at the new station. A further meeting to progress matters is planned for January 2015.

3.4 **Control and Mobilisation Improvement Project** – This project will complete the enabling works required to implement the new Tri-Service provided mobilising system. In advance of the new mobilising system Control staff have been successfully relocated from the old Headquarters to the refurbished 2nd Floor of Southern station.

The implementation of the new mobilising system was planned for 10th December 2014. However, this date has not been achieved. The Tri-Service Project Team are currently liaising with the supplier to re-plan implementation for February 2015.

- 3.5 Aerial Ladder Platform Replacement Project A decision was made to purchase one Scania based three axle Angloco Bronto 32RLER Aerial Ladder Platform (ALP). The finished product will be delivered in February 2015. Internal training and stowage solutions will then be completed prior to the ALP being operationally available from June 2015.
- 3.6 **Premises Information Improvement Project** The project plans to introduce improved business processes and deliver the vision of a single portal for access to all premises, location and risk information.

An exception report was approved by the Senior Management Team (SMT) in October 2014 resetting expectations in relation to future delivery dates. The feasibility report will now be presented at the end of March 2015.

The Open Wings upgrade took place on 9th October 2014. Process improvements will now be progressed along with the GMS to CFRMIS integration work which is all

planned to be completed by the end of quarter one 2015.

- 3.7 **SharePoint Infrastructure Architecture and Taxonomy Project** The Project Initiation Document (PID) was approved by SMT in September 2014 allowing the discovery phase to be undertaken. It is due for completion by the end of January 2015.
- 3.8 **Green Car Salary Sacrifice Scheme Project** The PID was approved at by SMT in November 2014. The project will implement a car salary sacrifice scheme by August 2015.
- 3.9 Wide Area Network (WAN) Replacement Project The PID was approved by SMT in December 2014. Virgin Media have been selected to undertake the implementation. The contract has been signed and the preparatory work is underway. The implementation is due to commence in February 2015 and be completed by June 2015.

A draft IRMP consultation document and communication plan were submitted for review at Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 3 Sep. The final draft IRMP consultation document and a 'closed' paper on the support staff review were presented to the CFA on 25 September 2014. The IRMP proposals were approved for consultation and the support staff review proposals were approved for implementation. The IRMP consultation will run from October to the end of December 2014 and be supported by Opinion Research Services (ORS). Weekly 'Early Bird' communication sessions are continuing to take place at various locations to provide both support and operational staff the opportunity to hear the latest position and ask questions. To date there have been over 1,000 responses to the consultation.
