PENSION FUND ADMINISTRATION REPORT

Purpose of the Report

- 1. To inform the Combined Fire Authority (CFA) Local Pension Board of firefighter pension administration activity in the quarter 1 October 2021 31 December 2021.
- 2. This is designed to assist the CFA Local Pension Board. It is also considered best practise to provide a report of this type.

Regulation Changes

- 6. The Public Service Pensions and Judicial Offices Bill has completed the second reading in the House of Commons and is still on track to receive Royal Assent.
- 7. The Home Office launched a consultation on amendments to the fire pension scheme regulations on 8 November 2021. The consultation closed on 2 January 2022 and these regulations need to be in force for 1 April 2022.

- 8. Finance (no.2) Bill this is primary legislation changes affecting remedy case and will impact on unauthorised payments, Scheme Pays and other tax areas.
- 9. Home Office consultation on the retrospective amendments is expected later this year.

Risk and Breaches - (material or not)

10. None.

Update on Sargeant case (transitional protections remedy)

11. WYPF is continuing to process cases in accordance with the instructions received from the FRA. The situation is constantly changing and WYPF is constantly changing to react to the new needs of its Fire clients.

Sargeant and Data Collection (age discrimination remedy)

12. The first test run has been completed which resulted in a number of data inconsistencies. These have been cleared and WYPF is hoping to produce the first full test data extract this week.

Matthews (retained/part-time firefighters)

13. There is no update on this. The Home Office should now have completed its consultations with interested stakeholders. The Home Office has indicated that there will be an 18 months' consultation period before the regulations come into force and then FRAs will have a further 18 months to complete the exercise.
