Killer Facts

- Men are twice as likely to crash as women
- Drivers under 25 are the most at risk of having a crash
- Those who drive old cars are most likely to be involved in a crash
- Young drivers are especially likely to be caught out by bends on country roads
- Young men are 10 times more likely to be killed or seriously injured in a car crash than those aged 35 or over
- Friday and Saturday nights are peak times for car crashes
- The risk of being in a car crash peaks immediately after passing the test, and gradually reduces over the following year
