



FAIR PROCESSING AND PRIVACY NOTICE

Service exercises where personal data is captured

Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service regard your privacy as important and comply with the Data Protection Act 2018. We record personal information to assist and aid in Learning and Development in operations, procedures, Incident Command and to support compliance with the Health and Safety At Work Act 1974.

We may capture video image and audio using cameras, body worn video and drones. Your personal data is held securely on our system and will not be shared with any other third party unless we have lawful basis to do so. We may share video images and audio with partners in the spirit of best practice set out in the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 for training purposes, exercising of JESIP and collaboration opportunities which may include TCG/SCG scenarios.

The information will be held until outdated by procedure or policy deems the footage obsolete and then we will securely delete it. You have the right to request that we stop processing your personal data providing your reasons of concern in writing.
