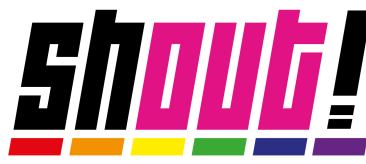

LGBT History Month (UK)	February	
International Transgender Day of Visibility	31 March	Celebrated to bring awareness to transgender people and their identities as well as recognize those that helped fight for rights for transgender people.
Holocaust Remembrance Day	12 April	Day to remember all of the victims of the Nazi era; see persecution of homosexuals in Nazi Germany and the Holocaust.
Lesbian Visibility Day	26 April	
International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia and Biphobia	May 17	To raise awareness of violence, discrimination, and repression of LGBT communities worldwide.
Harvey Milk Day	May 22	Celebrated to honour Harvey Milk, assassinated politician, on his birthday, it is celebrated officially in California, Milk's home state.
Pulse Night of Remembrance	12 June	Annual day of US remembrance for the loss of 49 people in the Pulse Nightclub shooting in Orlando, Florida on June 12, 2016.
Stonewall Riots Anniversary	28 June	To remember the Stonewall Riots that are described as the start of the Trans and Gay Liberation Movement in the United States.
Leicester Pride	1 September	Joint emergency services
Celebrate Bisexuality Day	23 September	Also referred to as Bisexual Pride Day, CBD, Bisexual Pride and Bi Visibility Day.
WEI Submission	tbc September	Stonewall WEI submission deadline
National Coming Out Day	11 October	
Intersex Awareness Day	26 October	Celebrated in October to commemorate the first intersex protest, which took place in Boston, MA
Transgender Day of Remembrance	20 November	
Intersex Solidarity Day	8 November	Marks the birthday of Herculine Barbin
Transgender Awareness Week	Typically the second week of November	The purpose is to educate about transgender and gender non-conforming people and the issues associated with their transition or identity.
International Stand Up to Bullying Day	Third Friday of November
