## 1. Purpose

- 3.2 The Committee has met on five occasions in the current municipal year. At its first meeting the Committee approved a work plan for 2013/14. As the CFA's audit committee, the Committee has considered all the audit reports prepared by internal and external audit.
- 3.3 In September 2013 the Committee reviewed the impact upon the differentials between staff and their immediate supervisors if staff at the bottom of the pay scale were uplifted to the Living Wage. This was a follow up report to the Committee's initial consideration of introducing the Living Wage in March 2013. Following the review the Committee recommended that the Living Wage should

be introduced and this was approved by the CFA with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013.
