The Combined Fire Authority's (CFA) Budget – Information Note

- 1. As part of the budget preparation process, the CFA is required to consult with representatives of local non-domestic ratepayers regarding the proposals and provide the following information. This note supplements the draft budget report with other information we are required to send you by law.
- 2. The CFA has prepared a three year financial strategy. On February 14th 2024, the CFA will approve its formal budget for 2024/25.
- 3. The CFA has proposed a budget of £47.9m in 2023/24 for the running of the Fire Service. This sum excludes sums spent on the capital programme. Of this, £27m was met from council tax and £20.9m from other income including government grants.
- 4. The CFA estimates that it will spend £48.4m on revenue services in 2023/24, the deficit will be funded from the authority's reserves. The CFA estimates it will spend £3.5m on its 2023/24 capital programme.
- 5. A representation of the budget proposals for 2024/25 by class of service is shown in the table below;
